## BRINGING FOOD RELIEF TO THOUSANDS

Week after week, rain or shine, with dozens of volunteers or less than ten, the **San Pablo - YLM Emergency Food Pantry Drive Thru** has faithfully distributed food boxes generously filled with produce and non-perishable food items **every Saturday morning**.

Close to 150 families – about 800 individuals – receive much needed food every week during these financially uncertain times. With the Mexico-US border opening up soon, the numbers of families suffering food insecurity are expected to double as more people come to San Pablo-YLM seeking relief.

## SUPPORT EDUCATION


Fifteen-year old Javier is halfway through his first year at Anapra's local high school. He dreams of becoming a missionary and spends his free time at Iglesia Luterana San Lucas, helping water the outside trees, sitting in on deaconess virtual courses, and attending both Wednesday Bible study and Sunday afternoon worship services.

"Thanks to the scholarship he was granted, we were able to get him a laptop for the days he has virtual classes," Enedina, his mother, shared.

Myron, a member of the church sponsoring Javier shared soon after receiving his picture and information, "Even more amazing, our church's first mission trip through YLM was planting those trees outside of San Lucas."

Education in Juarez is "free" yet many families cannot afford the cost of registrations, uniforms, school supplies, textbooks, and other scholastic needs. Prayerfully consider sponsoring a much needed **Stay in School** scholarship by giving **\$700 for one school year**.


## 2021 JOY DISTRIBUTION

# PARTNER WITH MISSION CONGREGATIONS

Your support of the mission-churches in Juarez has led to multiple baptisms, confirmation classes, lay leadership training, and deaconess courses. At Santisima Trinidad, a young man is working through vicarage courses and bringing the Word of God to the mission house-church in KM30. At La Santa Biblia, **baptisms are taking place almost monthly**. San Lucas is ministering to refugees through the offer of shelter, food, and weekly Bible study. Gloria Dei in Chihuahua is venturing, once again, into the mountains to bring God's Word and much needed resources to the Tarahumara Indians.

Through partnership with YLM, these mission-churches are fulfilling Matthew 28:19-20 by fulfilling Matthew 25:31-40. Continue to support these mission-churches in El Paso and Juarez through YLM, by bringing the Good News through catechism classes, pastoral counseling, materials, hospital and jail visits, and in many other ways alongside YLM.

## REFUGEE CARE

The last year and a half, several of the YLM partnering mission-churches in Juarez have opened their doors, and hearts, to migrants in need of shelter and care. **San Lucas, the only Juarez mission-church with a dormitory, has housed over 20 migrants**, adult and children, from Cuba, El Salvador, Honduras, and Haiti while they undergo the immigration process.

San Lucas, La Santa Biblia, and Cristo Rey have been working together, along with YLM, to provide shelter, food, clothing, transportation, and spiritual instruction for these migrants.

To continue offering **Refugee Care**, an estimated \$1,000 is needed each month. Prayerfully consider **giving \$1,000** to help these missions continue offering a safe place of refuge to displaced migrants in Juarez and El Paso.





# LUTHERAN PRISON MINISTRY

*"There's joy in knowing these marked Bibles will go behind bars to people in need of God's Word."*

Missionaries from Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Edmond, Oklahoma spent a couple of afternoons marking Bibles, which are given through the Lutheran Prison Ministry to immigration detainees and inmates throughout the United States.

These ladies were diligent, completing **ten Spanish Bibles and twenty English** in two days. Within the next month, Bibles and other Christian Literature to include the **Adelante!** ministry's songbook, will be delivered to the El Paso Immigration Center.

"They won't allow visitors due to Covid restrictions but we continue to provide materials for the chaplain", Pastor Heimer explained concerning the current situation, "We adapted the Lutheran Prison Ministry to the present reality so we can continue to carry God's Word to the nations, no matter where they are."

Through the Lutheran Prison Ministry, those behind bars throughout the United States will receive Bibles upon request.

Several attendees traveled from nearby Minnesota to one of the concerts. Sonya, a member of St. Paul Lutheran Loon Lake Church in Vergas, Minnesota, made the trip with her husband to the concert held in Sioux Falls, SD. "It was such a joy to watch them play. I love Mariachi San Pablo and have their CDs, but this was the first time I have seen them in concert".

For several years, **YLM** has been working with MOST, a non-profit organization


dedicated to facilitating short-term mission trips around the world. Last week of October, a team of eighteen from Brighton, MI, helped

“This was greatly needed”, **Pastor Hernandez**, shepherd of the mission-church in KM30, shared, “We have the opportunity to work alongside MOST to share the Gospel to so many people and meet their **need for glasses**”.

Those who came through the clinic left with big smiles and heads high, able to see clearly for the first time in years. “It was humbling and fulfilling to see children, parents, and elderly full of joy because they could see”, one of the members of the MOST team shared at the end of the week.

For many, glasses were all that was needed to be able to physically see clearly, but for everyone involved, the love of Jesus was seen even before glasses were put on.
